Battery storage: The next disruptive technology in the power sector

Battery storage prices are dropping and causing a dynamic and uncertain period. The evolution of this sector will hinge mainly on four factors: how quickly storage costs fall; how utilities adapt by improving services (incorporating new distributed energy alternatives and reducing grid-system cost); how nimble third parties are; and whether regulators can strike the right balance between encouraging a healthy market for storage (and solar) and ensuring sustainable economics for the utilities.
