Penny Hill, who previously served as the lead administrator at the college's TEC-SMART extension center, has been promoted to Dean of Economic Development and Workforce Initiatives.

Hill served as associate dean of TEC-SMART (Training and Education Center for Semiconductor Manufacturing and Alternative and Renewable Technologies) at the NYSERDA Saratoga Technology and

Energy Park in Malta for seven years, where she helped grow the Clean Technology and Sustainable Industries Early College High School, which enrolls students from more than 20 school districts.
